CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Because of PET yarn's absorbent properties, we suggest utilising this rug in covered areas and storing it indoors during rainy conditions. To ensure product longevity, we recommend bringing the floor rug indoors when not in use.

Outdoor floor rugs can be cleaned by washing with your garden hose, or with a damp cloth and warm soapy water. Hang outside to dry. Spot clean spills immediately, by gently dabbing at the mark. Use warm soapy water to clean water-based stains. Oil-based spills should be cleaned immediately with textile cleaning solution. Do not dry clean.

If using inside, lightly vacuum regularly using suction only. Avoid using a brush head, as this can cause matting of the fibres. You can also shake your floor rug outside to remove dust and dirt.

MANUFACTURING VARIATIONS & CONSIDERATIONS

This floor rug has been handcrafted by artisan makers. Although we strive for consistency in our products, the complex nature of this process may reveal minor variations.

SIZE This can vary +/- 3% from the size specified.

COLOUR You may notice slight colour variations from samples, online, and print images. As many of our products are handmade from natural fibres and materials, there may also be minor variations between production runs and dye batches. Every effort is made to ensure these are minimal and within textile industry standards.

POP-UPS Pop-ups occur when fibre ends or loops wriggle loose and appear above the natural pile height of the rug. Pop-ups are common in handwoven rugs and are not considered a fault. Maintain by trimming or pushing through to the underside.

COMMERCIAL STANDARDS

FIRE SAFETY: Pass

This floor rug collection passes the U.S. standard for flammability criteria (Code: 16 CFR 1630). This test determines the surface flammability of carpets and rugs, requiring them to self-extinguish after exposure to an ignition source, thereby reducing fire hazards.

UV COLOUR FASTNESS: 4

A colourfastness to light test determines fabric resistance to colour loss caused by UV light exposure (our harsh Australasian light can fade and damage fibres). Graded on a scale of 1 to 5, a test result of 1 indicates severe colour change, while grade 5 signifies strong resistance to fading.

CROCKING: Pass

This floor rug collection passes the AATCC 116 colour fastness to crocking. Crocking refers to the transfer of colour from the surface of a dyed or printed fabric to another material or surface through rubbing or abrasion - leading to unwanted staining or colour transfer. Crocking is tested under dry or wet conditions to assess a fabric's colourfastness.
